



Standards and Conditions of Student Membership

Student Member Requirements

- adhere to IDNB's code of Ethics and Standards of Practice;
- enrolled in an Interior Design Education Program that grants a CIDA-accredited degree;
- renew Student membership annually by December 31st;
- complete Intern Application Process at time of graduation.

Rights, Privileges and Limitations of Student Membership

Becoming a member of IDNB offers countless benefits and networking possibilities. The responsibilities of student members include the following privileges and limitations:

- authorization to use the designation "Student Member of Interior Designers of New Brunswick", or "Student, IDNB" after your name;
- volunteer opportunities on IDNB committees, task forces, as well as participation in Association events and seminars;
- are non-voting members;
- shall pay such fees established by the Board of Directors for student membership every year that individual is enrolled in a program; refer to the [IDNB Fee Structure](#)
- are responsible for maintaining and keeping up to date their Member Profile on the Interior Designers of New Brunswick website, granted upon review and approval of Membership

Education Requirements

As of July 1, 2015, a four-year interior design degree has been the minimum education requirement. Individuals who have graduated with a non-CIDA accredited bachelor's degree after January 1, 2017, will be directed to apply through the ARIDO process in order to pursue a career as a Registered Interior Designer.
